**Q** What is laser eyelid rejuvenation?

Laser eyelid rejuvenation by Dr. Mark Berkowitz—also called *laser blepharoplasty*—is an advanced method of surgical transformation for the upper and lower eyelids. It offers both functional and cosmetic improvement for patients of all ages with heavy, drooping eyelids.

**Q** Why is a laser used—instead of traditional techniques?
